<u>DETERMINATION OF BILLING ENERGY</u>: The kWh billing energy shall be the billing kW demand multiplied by 425 hours or the actual kWh energy used in the current month, whichever is greater.

<u>FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE AND ENVIRONMENTAL SURCHARGE</u>: All rates are subject to the Fuel Adjustment Clause and Environmental Surcharge provisions as established by regulations and approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- 1. If service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines, and other equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the member.
- 2. If service is furnished at Cooperative's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Cooperative's primary line to the member's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines, and other equipment, except metering equipment, on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the member.

<u>TERMS OF PAYMENT</u>: The above rates are net, the gross being five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within twelve (12) days from the date the bill was rendered, the prompt payment discount shall be forfeited and the gross amount shall apply.
