DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND: The kW billing demand shall be the contract demand plus any excess demand. Excess demand occurs when the member's peak demand during the current month exceeds the contract demand. The member's peak demand is the highest average rate at which energy is used during any fifteen-minute interval in the hours listed for each month and adjusted for power factor as provided herein.

<u>DETERMINATION OF BILLING ENERGY</u>: The kWh billing energy shall be the contract billing kW demand multiplied by 425 hours or the actual energy used in the current month, whichever is greater.

If service is furnished at Cooperative's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Cooperative's primary line to the member's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines, and other equipment, except metering equipment, on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the member.

<u>TERMS OF PAYMENT</u>: The above rates are net, the gross being five percent (5%) higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within twelve (12) days from the date the bill was rendered, the prompt payment discount shall be forfeited and the gross amount shall apply.
